**Re: Cease and Desist**

Dear Mr. Booth:

You have a number of postings on Bitcointalk.org that contain grossly false and misleading information relating to GAW Miners, LLC ("GAW"). My law firm represents GAW, and we are writing to let you know that GAW demands that you immediately cease and desist from disseminating such grossly false and misleading information by removing all offending postings from Bitcointalk.org.

These postings of yours at issue have irreparably harmed GAW and will continue to cause GAW to incur damages until they are withdrawn and/or corrected. An example of such a post is from November 9, 2014, at 10:43:29 p.m., when you, under the member name "KC6TTR," wrote that "GAW/Zen is a SCAM and you can quote me on that." You went on to allege that GAW "will either bail on their customers or the regulators will shut them down" and that there is evidence that one of these two scenarios will play out. All of these claims are unfounded and meritless, and you know it, as would any objective third party (including a court). Moreover, these postings of yours potentially expose you to significant civil liability, and GAW will not hesitate to aggressively defend itself and its hard-earned reputation through the legal system.


Given the gross falsity and misleading nature of your numerous postings about GAW, GAW understandably demands that you immediately remove all of your Bitcointalk.org postings that disparage GAW. My law firm will monitor Bitcointalk.org and expects to see all offending postings removed no later than within 24 hours.
